

Occupational Health & Safety Policy

Bluedog Fences Australia is committed to developing and implementing sound Occupational Health and Safety practices in all its business activities, at all its workplaces. Senior Management places the utmost importance on providing a healthy and safe work environment for all its employees. At all times Bluedog Fences Australia will endeavor to:

- Provide safe workplaces, plant and systems of work.
- Prevent workplace accidents.
- Comply with all the relevant Legislation (*Occupational Health and Safety Act 2000 NSW and Regulation*), Industry Standards and Codes of Practice.
- Foster an environment of cooperation and shared responsibility for Occupational Health and Safety throughout the organisation.
- Play an active role in the rehabilitation of injured workers so that they may return to some form of meaningful work at Bluedog Fences Australia as soon as possible.

To ensure that these goals are achieved Bluedog Fences Australia has developed an effective Occupational Health and Safety Management System (OHSMS). Important features that will be maintained are:

- A well documented system for identifying actual and potential workplace hazards, assessing their risk and controlling those risks.
- Establishing and documenting safe work procedures.
- On-going instruction and training of employees.
- Regular consultation with employees and dissemination of information about OHS issues.
- The allocation of adequate company resources to occupational health and safety.
- Regular review of the company's occupational health and safety performance including review of the OHSMS itself.
- In 2006 Bluedog Fences Australia underwent rigorous independent testing of its OHSMS. This system is now accredited to AS4801:2001.

This policy applies to Bluedog Fences Australia in all its operations.
